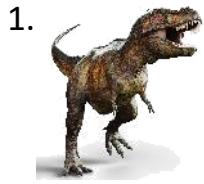

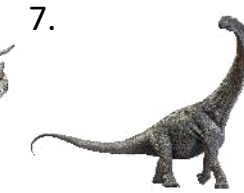

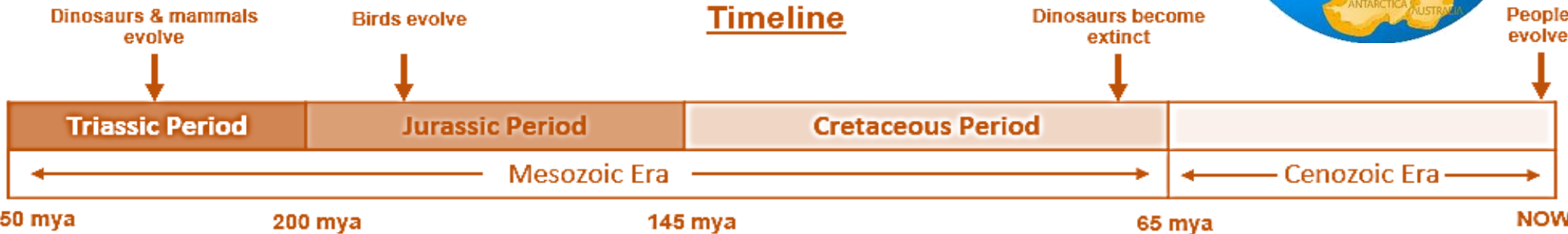

## VOCABULARY

<b>Carnivore</b>	An animal that feeds on other animals.
<b>Herbivore</b>	A animal that feeds on plants.
<b>Omnivore</b>	An animal that feeds on both plants and animals.
<b>Fossil</b>	The remains, or mark, of a very old plant or animal, left in a rock.
<b>Dinosaur</b>	A group of reptiles which lived on earth for over 160 million years, long ago.
<b>Mammal</b>	A warm blooded animal which has hair or fur, and gives birth to live babies.
<b>Extinct</b>	A kind of animal that used to be alive, but now all of them are dead.
<b>Palaeontologist</b>	A scientist who studies fossils of animals and plants.
<b>Pangaea</b>	All of the land used to be joined together in one supercontinent, called Pangaea.
<b>Reptile</b>	A cold-blooded animal with scales, which lays eggs.
