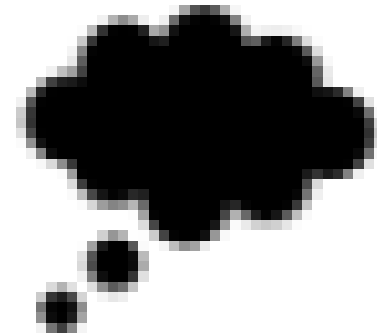

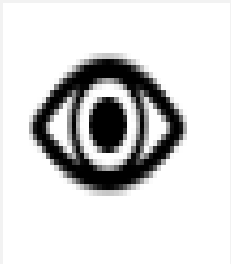

United Nations

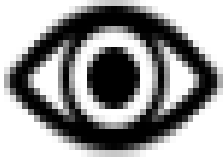
An organisation which aims to find peaceful solutions to conflicts, and promote global cooperation and human rights.
