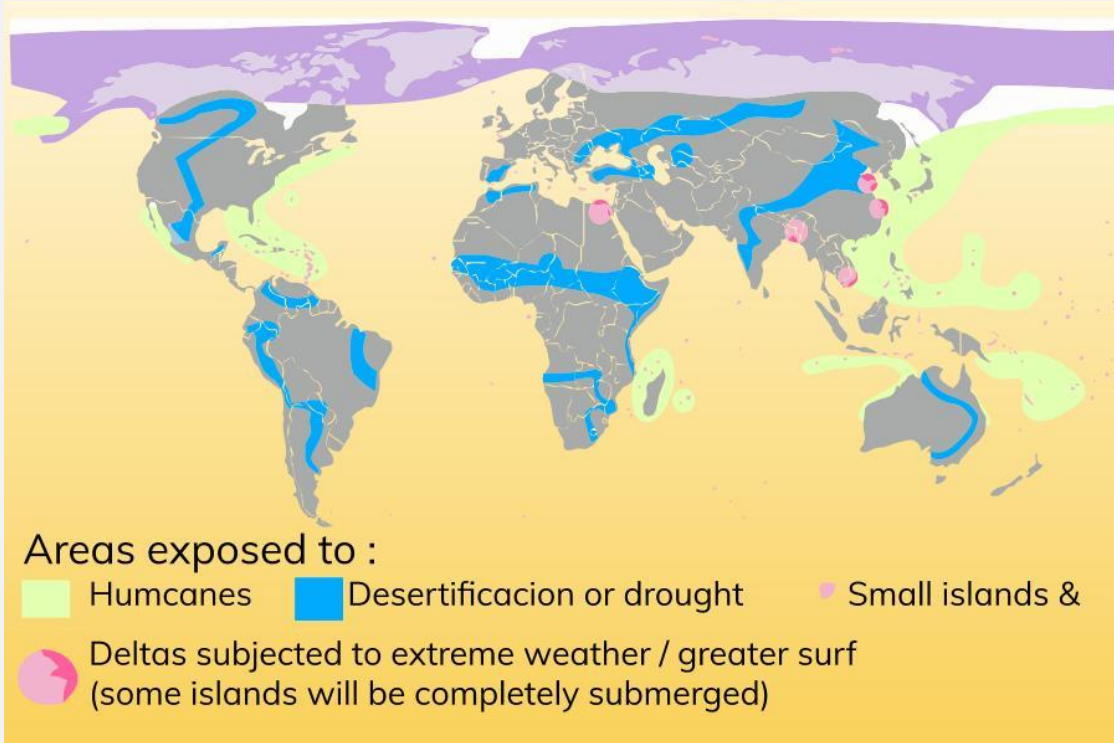
AS THE EARTH HEATS UP, ICE MELTS AND SEA LEVELS RISE.
