Mammal	an animal with warm blood and lungs.
Fish	a cold blooded animal with gills and a skeleton.
Crustacean	a cold blooded animal with a hard skeleton on the outside of its body.
Molluscs	a cold blooded animal with gills, some live inside a shell.

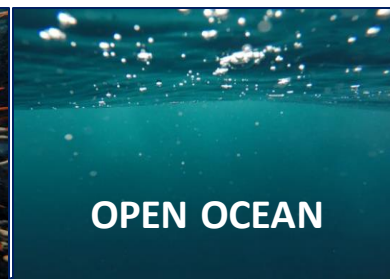

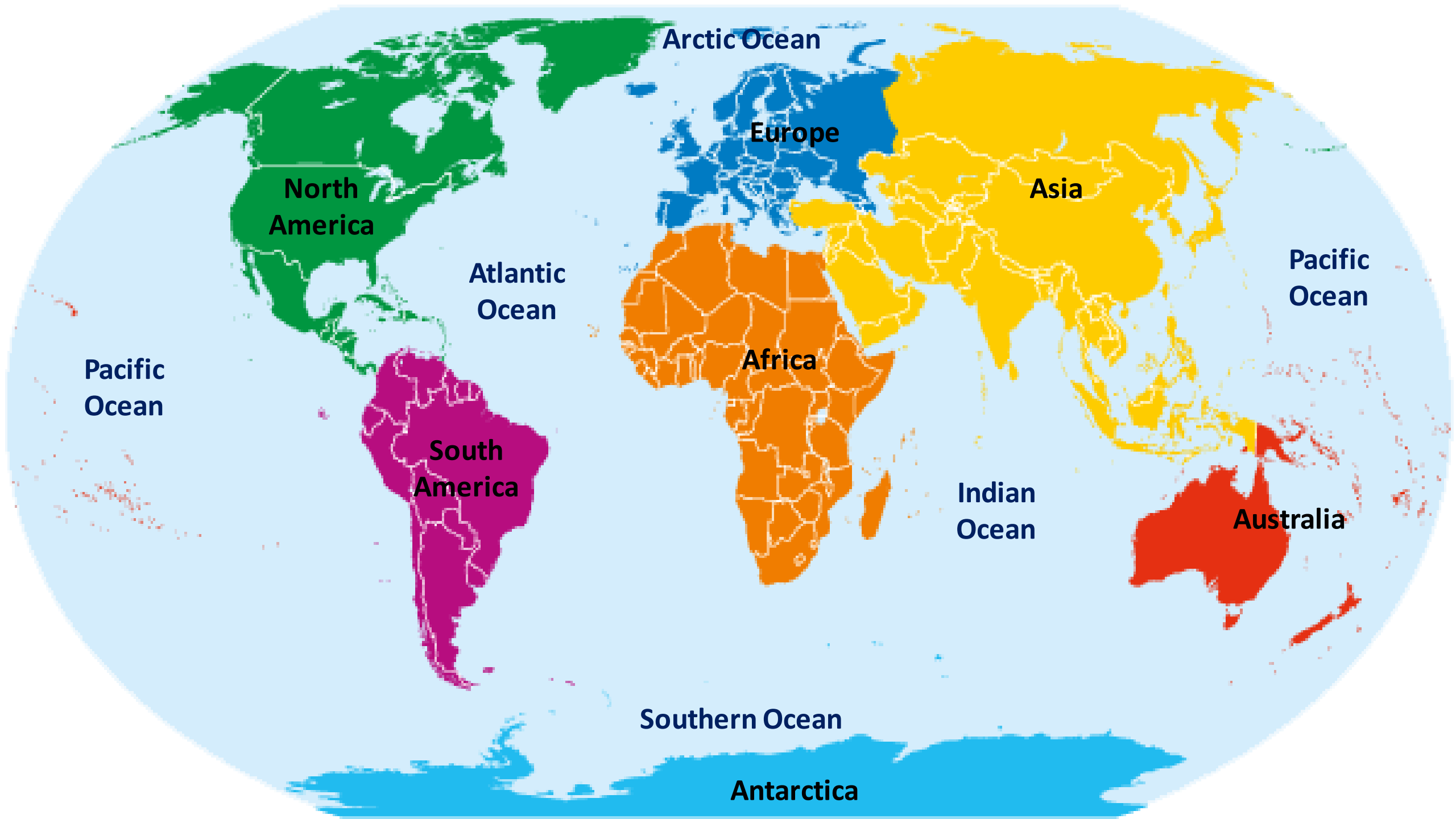
