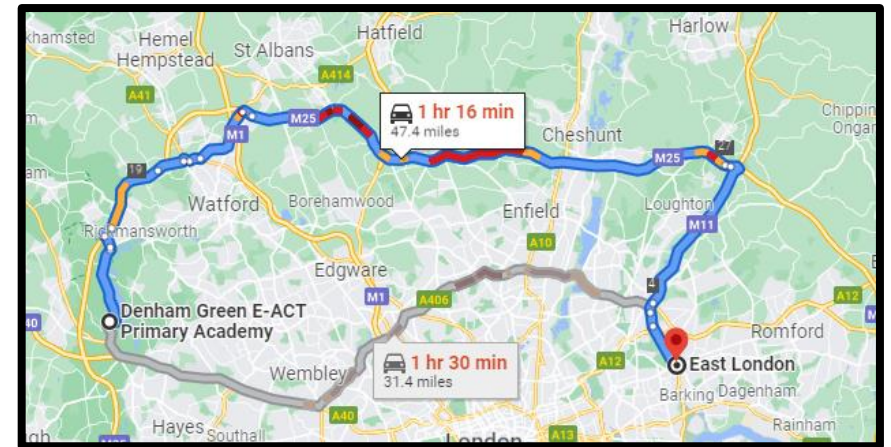
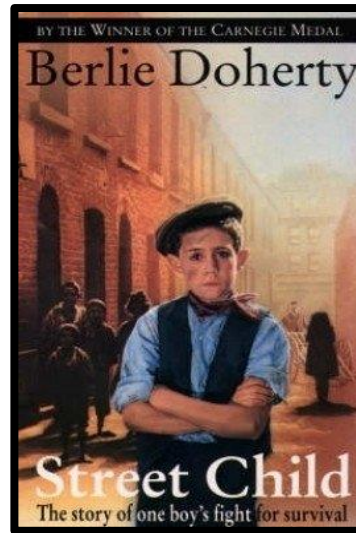

Key Vocabulary



Shilling	A former British coin and monetary unit equal to around twelve pence.
Workhouse	A public institution in which poor people – who couldn't afford to provide for themselves - received board and lodging in return for work. [Historical]
Coal shack	A shed in which coal is stored
Lordship	A respectful form of reference or address to a judge, a bishop, or a man with a title.
Broth	Soup consisting of meat or vegetables cooked in stock, sometimes thickened with barley or other cereals.
Infirmary	A place in a large institution for the care of those who are ill.
